The Florida Surplus Lines Association (FSLA) is an association with a current regular membership of Excess and Surplus Lines Agency member firms and associate members (made up of excess and surplus lines insurance companies, retail agencies, re-insurers, Lloyd's brokers, premium finance companies, surveyors and claim adjustment companies).

The purpose of the FSLA is to encourage an exchange of information among members and to disseminate educational information for the benefit of members and the betterment of the excess and surplus lines industry. Additionally, FSLA maintains liaisons with other segments of the insurance industry. Participants include commissioners, regulatory bodies, insurers and insurance producer groups. 



FSLA cheered the work of lawmakers prioritizing civil justice reforms this year, thanking lawmakers for the passage of HB 837.


